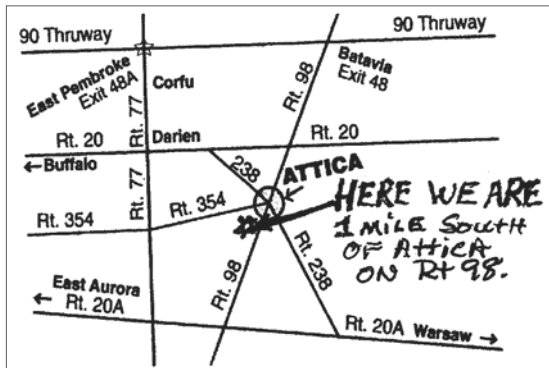

These days we don't get in very many dogs. Thankfully, our shelter manager is matching people who have dogs needing to be adopted with new Forever Families and they aren't coming into the shelter at all. We still get in strays, but only a few.

We do have over 300 cats who are patiently waiting for new Forever Families. Just because we don't euthanize, they still need homes. My friend called to say she had dinner at Alex's Restaurant in Batavia and saw kittens in the parking lot. I went the next morning to check. Cats, kittens all around the dumpster. Two tiny kittens with Mom were playing. I put down some canned food, the kittens started to eat, I picked them up and put them in the carrier. Mom walked across the parking lot and never looked back. I thought, "I'll never see her again." That was Sept. 2006. By February, I was down to 4 cats. It had taken all that time to catch 24. I went every night to feed them, by now the ones that were left waited for me. I set the trap and caught a cat I had never seen. The next morning I woke up and thought, "That's the Mom!" I couldn't believe it. I hadn't seen her since that first day. Soon I had everyone. Clarissa (Mom) and her sister, Diana were going to tear everyone apart. You couldn't even approach the cage, Clarissa would come through the bars. Hissing, spitting, claws out. I think Clarissa got Diana all wound up. After many long months they were released in the room where most cats are free. After many more months Clarissa started talking, rubbing, wanting someone to pay attention to her. Diana would appear in the middle of the crowd, fanny and tail up, "Here I am, please pet me!" Recently, Clarissa and Diana were adopted by Steven and Brenda Burg and are their TREASURES! All of these cats were feral. There was an old trailer park behind Alex's. People didn't get their cats spayed and neutered and this was the result. They lived in abandoned trailers and ate out of the dumpster. Please, consider adopting one of our TREASURES! They need you and the LOVE you'll receive is priceless!!! 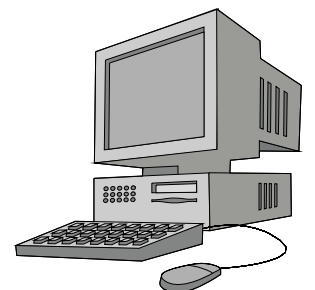
